***Britain's largest independent ship repairer, [Burgess Marine](#), enters the superyacht show season busier than ever. The company is currently working on four major yacht projects; two in the UK and two in the Mediterranean.***

Burgess Marine operates a 1000T [syncrolift](#) at its Portchester facility in Portsmouth Harbour where work is nearing completion on MY Coy Koi; the refit has encompassed annual Class works, blasting and painting.

Work also continues apace in Portchester onboard MY Tacanuya; the major refit of a 57m, 1992 Swiftship, will encompass structural, mechanical and electrical works. The vessel will also undergo paint works and a major interior overhaul by [Trimline Superyacht Interiors](#) and [Atlantic Contract Interiors](#).

Burgess Marine is also undertaking a major structural repair project in Toulon, at ISM, on behalf of the [Ocean Independence](#) yacht management team. The vessel is undergoing a major series of aluminium repairs; the contracted works consists of repairs to the fuel and fresh water tanks, bulkheads and garages doors.

Simultaneously the business is supporting a major mechanical overhauls and a significant pipe work project in [STP Palma](#).

Furthermore, and in partnership with Ocean Independence, [Laurent Giles](#) and [Rolls Royce](#) Burgess Marine has chosen the Monaco Yacht Show to formally launch [Project Nelson](#) (pg12-13) to the media. The press conference will take place on the Ocean Independence stand at 1700hrs on T Jetty; QT22 on Wednesday 24 September 2014.
