This tethered survey buoy is destined for operation off the coast of the United States of America, to be deployed for six month surveys, gathering data determining site suitability for wind farm development.

Burgess Marine has been engaged to provide the instrument platform at the top of the mast, and the tethers that secure the buoy to the gravity base on the ocean bed. Moreover Burgess Marine's Technical Team has worked closely with the projects designers to ensure both suitability of design and build feasibility.

With the buoy being unmanned for long periods, and maintenance specifically targeted to journeys between sites, Burgess Marine has drawn on its long established Marine Engineering experience to ensure that its finished product is not only fit for the six year intended lifespan of the buoy, but that each deliverable includes every consideration in respect of product handling, shipping, installation, operation and maintenance.
