BURGESS MARINE SUPPORTS FOUR MAJOR HSC REFITS IN FOUR MONTHS

Burgess Marine has committed to support four major Incat refits in the coming four months. The company will be working in both Portsmouth and Cherbourg in support of Condor Ferries and Brittany Ferries.

The Condor Ferries fleet begin their dockings in Portsmouth on October 28th with Condor Vitesse (the 86m Incat hull no. 044), with Condor 10 (the 74m Incat hull no. 030) following on November 23rd and finally Condor Express (the 86m Incat hull no. 042) on January 11th 2010.

The Brittany Ferries 98m Incat no. 057 Normandie Express will be docking simultaneously in Cherbourg to Condor Vitesse in Portsmouth. Burgess Marine will be the primary contractor on all four dockings and in addition will be managing the docking and undocking of Incat 057 on the syncrolift in Cherbourg.

Commenting on running two major dockings simultaneously Ray Cutts, Burgess Marine's Technical Director comments "we're in the fortunate position of having the highest levels of expertise in-house. Our Technical Management are all from the HSC Fast Ferry back ground, hence, with some careful planning this volume of work does not present us with a problem".
